



St. Paul Lutheran School Middle School Supply Checklist

All supplies should be labeled with the student's name.

- (1) One container to store school supplies that will fit in locker
- Pencils (traditional preferred; mechanical acceptable)- Give one small box of traditional pencils to your homeroom teacher to be kept in classroom
- 1 pencil pouch to carry pencils and other writing utensils to class
- (2) Two LARGE pink eraser
- Red pens
- Loose leaf notebook paper (prepare to replenish during the year)- give one package to your homeroom teacher to be kept in classroom
- 7th grade ONLY: Colored pencils
- Glue-give to your homeroom teacher labeled with your name
- Highlighters (several colors)
- Scissors- give to your homeroom teacher labeled with your name
- Ruler with metric and English units (12")
- (1) large binder/notebook system for English, History, and Science *OR*
(3) 1 ½ inch binders (1 for each class)
 - Divider tabs with folders for English (4 tabs), Math (5 tabs), and
(2) divider tabs for History
- (2) Two composition books – *no spiral* (Spanish and Science)
- (4) Packages of index cards for Language class (2) and (2) for Spanish-
- (1) One LARGE box of Kleenex- give to homeroom teacher
- 2 rolls of paper towels- give to homeroom teacher
- P.E. uniform
- Course 2 and Course 3 students need to supply their own calculator (Algebra 1 students will need a calculator with basic functions including square root and exponent keys).
- (5) JUMBO book sox AND (1) regular book sox are REQUIRED to cover books. NO self adhesive covers are allowed. "Book Sox" brand are preferred – they last all year!
- 6th - (1) One LARGE bottle of hand sanitizer to share with class

- **6th, 7th, & 8th grade- 1 box of storage size (gallon or quart size) Ziploc bags**
- **6th grade- 1 package of multi- colored fat [no thin!] Expo markers- give to Mrs. Smith**
- **(1) English/Spanish/Spanish/English dictionary (preferably the *University of Chicago Education*, generally found at Walmart)-**
- **USB flash drive- 1 GB is enough (for Mrs. Smith's class). To be kept in pencil pouch or in binder. LABEL clearly with your name.**
