## **Donations Limits**

GA House Bill 1133 allows you to redirect a portion of your state income taxes to the private school of your choice and receive a 100% dollar for dollar credit when you file your taxes. There is \$100M available annually for private school tuition scholarships.

As an SSO authorized by the Georgia Department of Education, GaSSO manages donations and approvals, then disburses tuition scholarships to designated partnering private school students.
