  - Your name
  - Your instructor's name (Miss Wiederrich)
  - The course (Reading)
  - And the date (ex: 7 August 2019).
- Hit enter ONCE and center the title. Do not underline, italicize, or place your title in quotation marks.
  - The only italicized part of your title should be the name of the book itself
- All paragraphs should be indented. DO NOT use the space bar to indent. Instead, use the tab button once per paragraph.
